He has devoted most of his research effort to the development of signal processing techniques and their application to diagnostic systems, especially in the context of medical problems. A recipient of a number of awards including a British Computer Society Medal, he is also holder of the Chair in Electrical Engineering at Oxford University and was elected to a Fellowship of the Institute of Electrical Engineers (IEE) and to a Fellowship of the Royal Academy of Engineering in 2000. He was made a Commander of the Order of the British Empire (CBE) in the New Year Honours List in 2012.

Professor Dr Norbert Peters, RWTH Aachen

Norbert Peters' primary research interest is in the field of combustion engineering. He has received a number of awards for his contributions in this field including membership of the United States National Academy of Engineering.

Ms Naomi Climer, SONY, USA


