

Engineers in Society Awards

Things to note

- These awards are open for third party nomination and self-application. We encourage teams to nominate themselves.
- A lead applicant or nominator will be asked to complete the online form (not every member of a team).

Criteria

- Applications and nominations must be for **teams only**. The team can be of any size and anywhere in the world.
- Must clearly demonstrate effective **teamwork** that has led to a societal benefit, this can include cross/multi/interdisciplinary working.
- For Judges to determine if a team aligns with the IET Societal Challenges, there must be some evidence provided of measurable societal impact in any of the following:
 - **Sustainability and climate change – securing a zero-carbon future**
 - **Digital Futures – promoting professional ethics and trust**
 - **Healthy lives – assisted living, robotics**
- Must be able to provide some feedback on the results achieved at the point of application. This should enable the judging panel to determine the **effectiveness of the teamwork**, not the output.
- Applicants should strongly consider the daily and longer-term advancements **made by their team**, and be able to demonstrate this clearly
- Submissions can be accepted from teams that show impressive work in progress delivered **by a team**, the activities of the team do not need to be final.
- Successful finalists and winners can re-apply but not for the same project.
