IET Apprentice and Technician Awards

The following 3 awards are available:

IET Engineering and Technology Apprentice

Recognise a current or recently completed apprentice who stands out from their peers and has made noteworthy achievements during their engineering apprenticeship. An individual who is a role model to others and is passionate about promoting engineering e.g. to schools or through volunteer work.

Criteria

- You can nominate someone, or you can self-nominate. If you self-nominate you must have a supporter who is your line manager or higher
- The apprentice must be on, or completed within the last year, an IET Approved Apprenticeship scheme
- They may have recently completed their apprenticeship
- They don't have to be an IET member / professionally registered

Show how the apprentice has:

- Made substantial contributions towards their employer or operational area, e.g. towards the development of a new product, service or process that demonstrates outstanding understanding of engineering principles
- Progressed towards the apprenticeship qualifications
- Gone above and beyond in their role, and why
- Shown evidence of engineering ambassadorial work

Prize

Trophy, certificate, £1,000 and two years' free IET membership including technician professional application fee, when winner is ready to apply.

IET Engineering and Technology Technician

Recognise a technician who's made an exceptional contribution.

Criteria

- You can nominate someone, or you can self-nominate. If you self-nominate you must have a supporter who is your line manager or higher
- The technician can be in any sector (e.g. engineering, technology, academic) in any country.
- The nominee does not need to be professionally registered
- Does not have to be an IET member

Show how the technician has:

- Demonstrated an exceptional contribution to their organisation.
- Made an exceptional commitment to engineering/technology through their technical and professional development.
- Gone above and beyond in their role, and why
- Other factors can enhance the nomination, e.g. engineering ambassadorial activities such as outreach events.

Prize:

Trophy, certificate, £1,000 and two years' free IET membership.

IET Armed Forces Technician

Recognise an engineering technician in any of the UK's Armed Forces. An individual who has demonstrated an exceptional commitment to the operational area.

Criteria

- You can nominate someone, or you can self-nominate. If you self-nominate you must have a supporter who is your line manager or higher
- The technician will be currently serving in the United Kingdom Armed Forces (Royal Navy, Army or Royal Air Force).
- Must be lower than a Warrant Officer in rank
- Does not have to be an IET member / professionally registered.

Show how the technician has:

- Demonstrated outstanding engineering or technical understanding and ability which has made an exceptional contribution to the area of operation.
- Made an exceptional commitment to engineering/technology through their technical and professional development.
- Gone above and beyond in their role, and why
- Shown evidence of engineering ambassadorial work

Prize

Trophy, certificate, £1,000 and two years' free IET membership.
