This document outlines the IET Academic Books policy on expectations and requirements for re-using copyrighted material in IET academic books.

Policy

The submitted chapter or book should be an original and previously unpublished work.

The author (as identified in the author or contributor Agreement) is responsible for obtaining permissions from copyright holders for any third-party material to be used in the work. If the work contains extracts (including illustrations) from, or is based in whole or in part on other copyright works (including, without limitation, material from online sources), the author must obtain from the owners of the respective copyrights written permission to reproduce those extracts in the work in all territories and editions and in all media of expressions and languages. The author must also provide full credit to such works.

Should you be unable to obtain any permission in the required form then the IET may, at our discretion, decide not to include the relevant material in the work.

All works submitted for publication in IET academic books are subjected to plagiarism detection software.
