In order to protect our reputation, and those of our authors and editors, on receiving your book proposal we will:

- Use the Retraction Watch Database to investigate the retraction records of prospective authors and editors before approving new book proposals.
- Personally manage communications with proposal peer reviewers to reduce the risk of review manipulation.
- Take steps to check that prospective authors and editors are who they say they
 are.
- Strongly discourage open call-for-chapter books.

These actions are intended to give genuine editors and authors complete confidence in working with the IET to continue to publish scientific and technical information of the highest quality.

Use of AI tools

The IET does not accept books or chapters for publication that are wholly generated by Al tools. The IET does not recognise Al tools as authors or able to fulfil authorship criteria, as they cannot take responsibility for the submitted work. Where Al tools are used in the preparation of any part of a book chapter for publication in an IET academic book, the author has full responsibility for the chapter in its entirety, and use of the Al tool must be clearly disclosed in the appropriate section of the chapter by the author.
